**MINUTES OF THE MEETING of THE AD HOC COMMITTEE BOXING  
FEDERATION of INDIA HELD VIRTUALLY (Via Zoom) AT 11.30 AM ON  
26.02.2025.**

Members Present:

At the Outset the Chairman Welcomed all the members and after exchange of Compliments thanked them for being present for the meeting at a Short Notice. He emphasized on the the need to hold virtual Meeting frequently. The Following agenda were discussed in details.

**AGENDA**

1. Finalising the Date and venue for physical/ hybrid meeting:  
After detailed discussions it was decided that Members should convene regular meetings Virtually even if at shorter notice or as convenient Physically from time to time till the Elections of the new Governing Council are held and a New Committee for Boxing Federation of India is elected.



It was further suggested by the Vice Chairman Sh Rajesh Bhandari that the Indian Olympic Association may again be requested for allotment of suitable space for functioning of the BFI adhoc Committee in the IOA Bhavan for holding Physical Meetings and other works in relation to Boxing or as may be required and to run the affairs of the ad hoc Committee including subsequent conduct of the Elections of the Boxing Federation of India thereof.

The proposal was agreed by all Members unanimously and it was decided that Chairman will contact IOA President for the above.

## 2. Preparing a road Map for elections of Boxing Federation of India:

The detailed Road Map for the Elections were discussed, the members expressed their concern about conducting free and fair elections of the BFI at earliest and not beyond the second/ third week of April 2025. It was deliberated that the process of initiating the elections should be started immediately as per the constitution of BFI and NSDC 2011 and that necessary steps be initiated within this week only.

It was further decided that the Elections should be conducted by appointing a Hon'ble Retired Justice of High Court to conduct the elections of BFI as per the details laid down in NSDC 2011 and Constitution of the Federation. It was further Unanimously decided that in the Best interest of the Sport and its Athletes the elections has to be conducted at earliest.

## 3. Appointment of Returning Officer for elections of BFI: As Discussed in agenda 2 it was unanimously decided that a Retired Hon'ble Justice of Hon'ble High Court be appointed as the Returning Officer for the elections of the Federation within the next couple of days and the name will be finalised in the Committee.

## 4. Venue for the elections of BFI:

It was Unanimously decided that the Venue of the Elections by kept at the IOA Bhavan New Delhi, for which the Chairman was requested to intimate / Request the IOA for the suitable space. In other case we should be ready for another venue for the meeting also.

5. Discussion on complaints of disciplinary issues:

The Matter regarding the Complaint filed by Mr Kuldeep Sharma and in reference to the letter issued by Sports Authority of India it was pointed out by Mr Bhandari that the formation of One Men Committee by the erstwhile BFI is incorrect, Bias and Unilateral. The Adhoc Committee deliberated and discussed that since there is an Adhoc committee now in existence, the powers of all officials/Committees/Subcommittees cease to be, hence the formation of One Member Committee has no significance and any decisions in this regard will be taken by the Next elected Committee of the Federation. It was decided that since the Elections are due and it has been resolved to conduct the same within next 2 months the action on this account may be considered by the New Committee after elections of BFI.

6. Streamlining the boxing events during the pendency of BFI elections:

The matter of ongoing activities and the forthcoming Events was deliberated and it was unanimously decided that Mr Shiv Thapa, Mr Shiv Thapa, Mr Bhatt, Mr Virender Singh will work out a plan after due deliberations with Senior Coaches/Ex elite boxers to prepare the modalities of selection criteria/ Trial or other mode of selection of the Team within next 3 days and the proposal will be put forth and discussed in the upcoming Committee Meeting in order to facilitate the Boxers of India. The Sports Ministry may also be communicated for the same so as to facilitate the Boxers of India.

7. Any other matter:

There being no other Matter, the Meeting Ended with Vote of thanks by Mr Rajesh Bhandari- Vice Chairman.
