**Subject: Invitation for Letter of Intent (LOI) to host state volleyball leagues**

All concerned parties are hereby informed that the Fédération Internationale de Volleyball (FIVB) has already finalized its official volleyball events calendar for the year 2026 to 2028. In order to prevent scheduling conflicts, all volleyball leagues, competitions, and national championships must be aligned with this sports calendar.

In light of the above, the Steering Committee of the Volleyball Federation of India (VFI) is pleased to announce the available dates during club championships for conducting state leagues, as detailed below:

Year	Women	Men:
2026	October 2 to December 31, 2026	October 16 to December 31, 2026
2027	October 4 to December 31, 2027	October 18 to December 31, 2027
2028	October 2 to December 31, 2028	October 16 to December 31, 2028

Interested organizations are hereby invited, through this circular, to submit a **Letter of Intent (LOI)** to the Steering Committee VFI to [vfisteeringcommittee@gmail.com](mailto:vfisteeringcommittee@gmail.com) expressing their desire to host a league. The LOI must include comprehensive details covering the following:

- Availability and adequacy of sports infrastructure
- Proposed venue, dates, and category (men or women)
- Accommodation arrangements for players and officials
- Transportation facilities and logistics
- Budget outline and sponsorship opportunities

Additionally, interested organizations are required to obtain the necessary consent and approvals from relevant government departments and stakeholders prior to submission.

The Steering Committee, VFI, will duly scrutinize all received Letters of Intent and respond to the respective organizations based on slot availability and other relevant considerations, including proximity to airports and railway stations, and the quality of accommodation facilities.

It is also notified that in case any state volleyball association (affiliated or non-affiliated or having disputes within state) is granted permission to host state league, shall not claim of being granted as recognized state volleyball association before any court of law, sports council or any other adjudicating agency.

It is hereby expressly notified that no volleyball league shall be recognized or granted official permission without the explicit approval of the Steering Committee, VFI. Organizations conducting leagues without such authorization will not receive any recognition from the Federation.
